## HELP REQUIRED

Please consider if you could help with any of these roles – for 1, 2 or all 3 mornings (9am – 1pm Wed 23<sup>rd</sup>, Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> or Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July)

### ALL ROLES

You will arrive as early as you can (9am or as close to this as possible!) to help set up, receive instructions for the session, and pray for that day

#### 1. SMALL GROUP LEADERS AND HELPERS

1 leader and 1 helper for each group of max 8 children

- You will greet the children in your group as they arrive, get to know them and help them feel welcome and comfortable.
- You will coordinate the craft activities for your group at their table (all instructions and materials will be provided)
- During the craft activities you will make the most of opportunities to have meaningful discussions with your group about that day's story, talk about God and what He means to you and answer any questions – conversation prompts will be provided
- You will sit with your group during the up-front times (listening and joining in with songs, DVD, puppets, games etc)
- You will help clear up and prepare for the next day after the children have left.
- You will be supported by 2 co-ordinators who will be always available to help.

#### 2. RECEPTION DESK and SECURITY

- You will be at the reception desk and help children and parents through the registration and welcome process prior to them joining their groups

- You will man the exits during the session to ensure no unaccompanied children or parents enter or leave the hall
- You will help ensure that all children leave safely at the end of the sessions

### **3. REFRESHMENTS**

- You will prepare the refreshments for each session (these will be provided and will be very simple eg squash and biscuits)
- You will check with the registration team about children with food allergies
- You will tidy up after refreshments have been served

### **ALL ROLES**

- This is a Bible Club so all our volunteers will be Christians. We will seek confirmation from your church leadership team that the role you will be helping with is right for you (only if we don't know you though!).
- You will be expected to sign a DBS (Disclosure and barring service) declaration, although will not undergo a formal DBS check with the Baptist Church). If you already have a CRB/DBS form we would like to see a copy if possible.
- You will be expected to work safely with children, in line with our safeguarding policy, and we will give guidance about good practice.
